

50 - Points to Pentecost

1. Enoch was rapture at 365 years of age - **365 days from Passover/Judgment 5/21/11** - falls on the 27th day of the 2nd month (*May 19, 2012*) *Iyar* – the day Noah entered dry land at 601 years old (*Genesis 8:14-16*). May 19, 2012 is exactly 7000 years later.
2. Enoch was caught up into heave in 7106 BC, which is 2116 years (**4x 23x 23**) before the door to the ark was shut in 4990 BC (*Gen 7:16*).
3. Pentecost is the feast of **"wheat harvest"** at **"the year's end"** (*Exodus 34:21-22*) – which Christ states is "the end of the world" in the parable of the wheat and the tares. (*Matthew 13:39*)
4. Pentecost is the **feast of weeks**, (*Exo 34:22*) 7 weeks + 1 day from Passover – Total 50 days, identifies with the Feast of Trumpets pointing to the Jubilee year (*Lev 25*).
5. The "blessed" waiting 1335 days (*Dan 12:12*) = 3.65 years; spiritually translates to waiting in faith for the rapture of Enoch, who lived 365 years / **"7th"** generation from Adam (*Jude 1:14*). May 19, 2012 will be 7000 years and 365 days from the flood.
6. "Enoch" means dedication / teacher & identifies with the **Feast of Dedication** (*Feast of Lights*) and the rapture - *John 10:22-24* - where Christ was asked "How long dost thou make us to doubt (*G142 airo– raised up*)?" In other words: **"When is the rapture?"**
7. Enoch is traditionally noted to be born and "caught up" on Pentecost by the Jews, as the event of Hanukkah is also historically recorded at 164 BC. (*John 21:25;10:22-23*)
8. National Israel was reborn on Pentecost - May 14, 1948 (*prophetic fact - Matt 24:32-34*)
9. Church was born with baptism of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost at 33AD (*Acts 2:2-4*)
10. John the Baptist declared the first church Pentecost 1335 days (*3.65 years*) prior with the announcement and baptism of Christ in 29AD. (*Daniel 12:12*) (*John 1:23-36*)
11. Holy Spirit bestowed **power "to know the times or the seasons"** of the restoration of the kingdom when it came at Pentecost. (*Acts 1:1-8*)
12. Pentecost is identified with the covenant/Promise (*Acts 4-5, Luke 24:49*) – typified by the engagement of marriage before the eternal wedding in heaven. (*Matt 25:1-13*)
13. The Ascension was in **"like manner"** an eight -day journey to Pentecost. (*Acts 1:9-11*)
14. Repeated 1335 time-paths interconnecting the Feast of Dedication, Passover & Tisha B'Av over the past two decades point to Pentecost – Promise studies: **"Blessed is He that Waiteth, The Third Watch, Keeping the Dedication"**
15. Joel prophesizes that Pentecost is the "harvest" & "valley of decision". (*Joel 3:14-17*)

16. In fulfillment of His obligation to be present at Pentecost, Christ attended the Feast of Dedication in Jerusalem, the winter Feast of Lights / Hanukkah / Feast of Enoch (*John 10:22-24*)
17. "I will tarry at Ephesus (*wicked city - Acts 19:35*) until Pentecost" where "there are many adversaries" during the great tribulation. (*1 Corinthians 16:8-9*)
18. The giving of the Ten Commandments on Tablets ("*Gift*" of Instructions) at Mt. Sinai was on Pentecost. (*Exodus 24:15-18*) (*Romans 9:4*) (*Ephesians 6:2*) (*Daniel 12:4*)
19. "Pentecost" is mentioned "3" times in bible for a "**purpose**" (*Act 2:1, 20:16, 1 Cor 16:8*)
20. The word "Promise" is mentioned "50" times in the bible points to **Pentecost**.
21. Enoch's reference to "10,000 saints" in Jude 1:14-15 points to Moses' blessing on Pentecost of the elect at Mount Sinai in Duet. 33:2
22. Pentecost / Promise is associated with the word "tarry" (50 times) (*Luke 24:49*) (*Acts 1:4*) The "**appointed time**" relates to assemble, festival (*H1450*) and marriage (*H2359*).
23. Pentecost relates to counting from Passover – (*Lev 23:15*); like 365 days from 5/21/11
24. Enoch & Noah are the only two prophets in the bible noted to having "walked with God" (*Gen 5:22-24; 6:9*) The Feast of Enoch is 8 days, as the 8 on the ark were saved.
25. King Hezekiah desired to know when to "go up to the house of the Lord" on the "3rd day." (*2Kgs 20:5-8*) His added 15 years (3×5) is "purposed" to relate to Pentecost.
26. Amazing time path of 723,996 days ($2^2 \times 3^3 \times 7 \times 13^2 \times 17$) from John the Baptist's announcement at Trumpets 9/28/29 to Pentecost at the Feast of Dedication 12/21/11, 7 months from 5/21/11 - precisely 7,000 years from flood 4990 BC. (*2 Pet 3:3-8*)
27. The 7th day of the Feast of Dedication 12/28/11 (*1st day of the tenth month*) is recorded in Genesis 8:5 as the date when the top of the mountains were seen; when it was discovered that 365 days counted to 5/19/12, the 27th day of the 2nd month.
28. The "**top of the mountains**" relate to seeing glory on the mountain or the **Transfiguration**, when Christ was transfigured ("*metamorpho*"- transform outside to inside) with Moses and Elijah who were **caught up with the disciples**. (*Luke 9:33-34*)
29. Mount Olives is where the disciples asked "when shall these things be" (*Matt 24:3*) and the same mount where the two men in white robes (*Rev 6:11*) answered that the rapture was a Sabbath journey (*se'nnight 8 days + 3 = 11*) away to Pentecost..(*Acts 1:9-11*)
30. Revelation 11:9-11 – where the two witnesses lie dead in the street for 3 ½ days once their testimonies are finished, relates to Elijah stopping rain for 3 ½ years & points to John the Baptist who prophesized Pentecost after 1335 days. (*Matt 11:12-14*)

31. Pentecost is the feast of first fruits indicating the arrival of summer. (*Matthew 24:32*)
32. Hanukkah observes the liberation & rededication of the 2nd Temple 164 BC when a portion of olive oil is miraculously sufficient to last 8 days. (*Historian - Flavius Josephus*)
33. The parable of the 10 virgins wedding preparation of oil light (*Mat 25:1-13*) references the doubling of the number “5” (*pente*) simulates the menorah account of Hanukkah.
34. John the Baptist leaped in the womb hearing of Christ in the “3rd month.” (*Luk 1:41*)
35. Pentecost points to redemption and judgment as Moses slays 3000 in the wilderness, while 3000 were saved after the crucifixion. (*Exodus 32:27-28*) (*Acts 2:14-41*)
36. ***Pentecost is the biblical the end of the year.*** (*Exodus 34:22*) (*Duet 11: 10-12*)
37. Pentecost relates to eternity eight – circumcision 8 days (*Gen 17:9-12*) (*1 John 2:25*)
38. Pentecost on May 22, 1988, the 13000th year of the world, ended the church age and began 23 years of global gospel distribution until 5/21/11. (*Mat 24:14, Luk 21:24-25*)
39. Pentecost has the same “50” number count as the jubilee year. (*Lev 25:4-13*)
40. Pentecost relates to perfection 7 x 7 and a “*certain*” promise (*double multiple of 7*)
41. Pentecost relates to God’s sufficient provision for 5,000 from “five loaves” and two fish divided in groups of “50” (*Luke 9:12-17*)
42. Pentecost is related to God’s appearance on Mt. Sinai and the “11” in upper room (*Mar 16:14*). God “appeared” to Abraham when circumcised at 99 (*11x 3²*). (*Gen 17:1,24*)
43. Pentecost is identified with signs of the stars, moon and sun. (*Joel 2:30*) (*Acts 2:19*)
44. Pentecost identifies with the **faith** (*evidence*) of Enoch and the prophets. (*Heb 11:1-31*)
45. Pentecost is tied to Sarah – according to the time of life. (*Gen 18:10,14*) (*Rom 9:9-11*)
46. Pentecost is associated with God’s oath to the seed of Abraham. (*Luke 1:72-74*) (*Gen 17:7-13*) (*Gal 3:14-18*)
47. Isaac is the first child to be circumcised at eight – sign of faith. (*Gen 17:12*) (*Gal 4:28*)
48. Zacharias ***miraculously spoke*** at John the Baptist’s 8th day circumcision (*Luke 1:64*)
49. John the Baptist cried from the **wilderness** “the kingdom of **heaven** is at hand” (*Matt 3:1*) “Promise”/covenant refers to the land of Canaan / heaven. (*Psalm 105:11*)
50. Pentecost is tied to the conclusion of God’s testing program. (*Numbers 14:34*)
